Shawn started to ski at the age of six at the London Ski Club. Shawn continued to instruct skiing through his high school and college years but at age 19, he switched to a snowboard after realizing they were actually building jumps for snowboarders.

After two full seasons at Blue and after completing his Level 2, Shawn made the move to Georgian Peaks as the Snowboard Supervisor. Shawn began running a successful Freestyle Ski Program and has looked after the Peaks League programs for the past seasons.
